## **EVALUTATION CRITERIA**

The evaluation of the applicants' curriculum is equal to the sum of the scores obtained applying the following criteria: a) grade average; b) further bonuses

Bonus	Additional points
Exams "cum laude" (praise/distinction/honours)	0.20 (for each "laudem")
REGULAR ACADEMIC CAREER :	4
-students who have completed 75% of the exams towards their Bachelor degree (or equivalent title) and who have – at the time of application – these exams already registered in their transcript	
Or	
- Students who completed their Bachelor degree (or equivalent title) no more than 2 years before application time	
KNOLEDGE OF THE ENGLISH LANGUAGE: Students who have, at the time of application, a valid certification of English language (see Attachment A for the list of accepted certifications) confirming a minimum B2 level of English language knowledge;	2
N.B: the certification cannot be used as a bonus if necessary to satisfy the minimal entry requirements (lack of 5 credits in English language in the university career)	

INTERNATIONAL STUDIES EXPERIENCE	3
Students who have registered in their transcript at least 24 credits (i.e. 15% of the exams counting towards the Bachelor degree or equivalent title) linked to exams entirely taken using the English language (not counting exams of English Language) at a foreign university (i.e. in a country different from the one where the student resides)	
GMAT certification, or GRE certification with score converted in GMAT (see this link for GRE>GMAT score conversion)	See table 3b *

GMAT score (or GRE converted)	Additional points
Less than 300	1
301-450	2

More than 550	Eligibility to enroll assigned automatically (not considering any other scores illustrated above)
