Call for late applications

A call for <u>late applications</u> for the academic year 2019-2020 is activated.

The procedure described below is dedicated to **students who graduated in a foreign (non-Italian) University**. Students who graduated in an Italian can find the precise description of the application procedure in the Admission Announcement written in Italian language.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

The academic qualification and adequacy of the basic knowledge of candidates who graduated in a foreign university will be assessed through the evaluation of the learning contents of the study programme and of the documentation attached to the application. Study programmes in History and Literature are considered adequate for the admission.

Students who are not native English speakers must possess an English language proficiency certification of at least B2 level. The following certifications are considered adequate: Cambridge *First* Certificate, Trinity College ISE, IELTS, TOEFL, or at least 12 Credits (CFU) of English language courses obtained during their academic career in the Bachelor's degree programme.

Students graduated abroad who want to enroll in the Master Programme The Ancient Mediterranean World must follow the procedure described below. <u>The application procedure must be sent between October 21</u> and November 8, 2019.

- 1. Candidates must apply for a pre-evaluation of academic qualification via the DreamApply portal at page https://apply.unipv.eu/courses/course/128-ancient-mediterranean-world-history-archaeology-and-art?search=14722. The application requires the payment of a 35 € application fee.
- 2. An appointed Commission will evaluate the academic curricula of the candidates. The results of the evaluation will be sent by email. Eligible candidates will be invited to continue the application process and to register for an admission interview.
- 3. Eligible candidates will have to register at page https://studentionline.unipv.it/AddressBook/ABStartProcessoRegAction.do and to apply following the procedure described in the admission announcement published on July 2, 2019 https://web.unipv.it/formazione/iscriversi-a-una-laurea-magistrale-plus/prove-di-accesso-obbligatorie-ma-non-selettive-plus/). The website is available also in English language.
- 4. After registration, candidates will have to select the link **Secretariat > Evaluation test** from the menu on the upper right corner in their reserved area.
- 5. Candidates will have to fill the application for admission interview and to upload the required documents (the complete list is indicated in the Admission Announcement). At the end of the procedure, candidates must print the receipt of application. The receipt contains the place and time of the admission interview.
- 6. The registration procedure will also produce an invoice for the payment of an admission test fee (35 €). Since the fee has already been paid in step 1, candidates are exempted from the payment and will have to send the payment receipt to matricole.umanistiche@unipv.it.

The admission interview will take place on Friday, November 15, 2019 at 15:30 (3:30 pm) in Room SMU (Music History room), Department of Humanities, University of Pavia, Corso Strada Nuova 65, Pavia.

Professor Maurizio Harari is the Coordinator of the Master Programme and Chairman of the evaluation commission and will be assisted by Professor Maria Elena Gorrini. Students holding a Degree awarded by a foreign University can request to take the interview via Skype and/or in a different date. Students who want to sit the interview via Skype or in a different date must contact the e-mail address medarch@unipv.it.

On the day of the admission interview, students will have to bring:

- 1. The identity document used to register for the admission interview. Non-EU students will also have to bring their VISA or the permit of residence.
- 2. The receipt of application for the admission interview.
- 3. The receipt of payment of the admission test fee.

ENROLLMENT

Accepted students will have to enroll between **December 2-13, 2019**.

To enroll, students will have to follow the procedure described in the Admission Announcement (https://web.unipv.it/formazione/iscriversi-a-una-laurea-magistrale-o-ad-una-laurea-magistrale-plus/prove-di-accesso-obbligatorie-ma-non-selettive-plus/) at sections 7 and 8. As indicated in the Admission Announcement, students will have to start the enrollment online and complete the procedure hand delivering the required documents at the student secretariat.

Students will have to pay a tuition fee. Tuition fees can be calculated according to a flat fee or to their family income. For precise information please see pages http://medarch.unipv.eu/tuition-fees/ and http://wcm-3.unipv.it/site/en/home/fees-and-funding/fees.html. Since regular enrollments were possible between October 3-15, students will be required to pay an additional 82 € fee for late enrollment.

Students who are required to take individual courses and exams to meet the entry requirements must complete the additional requirements (which include taking and passing exams) and hand deliver the enrollment application to the student secretariat of Humanities (Via Sant'Agostino 1, Pavia) by March 2, 2020. CONDITIONAL ENROLLMENT

Accepted students who will graduate after **December 13, 2019**, will have to apply for a conditional enrollment. In order to regularly enroll, students will have to graduate by March 2, 2020. Students who fail to graduate by this deadline will lose their status and the first installment of their tuition fee will be refunded. Students who graduated before the deadline (March 2, 2020) will have to immediately notify the student secretariat and prepare a self-certification of the graduation with a list of the passed exams, the corresponding credits and marks.
