

On January 1st, 2018, IUSS was awarded a Department of Excellence (Dipartimenti di Eccellenza) by the Italian Ministry of Education in the areas of Civil Engineering and Architecture. It is a five-year project and it is funded with 6.650.000 euro.

The proposal by IUSS finished first with a perfect score among the 14 departments recommended for funding across Italy.

The project includes three research thrusts:

- The development of a holistic approach for assessing the risk and resilience of critical infrastructures subjected to various natural hazards;
- The development of methods and technologies aimed at reducing expected losses in buildings due to seismic and other extreme events;
- 3 The review of the evaluation of the actions induced by seismic motions on civil infrastructure.

The project includes also the construction, in collaboration with the EUCENTRE Foundation in Pavia, of a unique seismic simulator capable of reproducing earthquake actions on large-scale structural and non-structural elements.

Finally, the project will establish an International Earthquake Engineering Museum in Pavia.
